

ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

We are writing to advise you that on Sunday 4 May 2025 the AJ Bell Great Birmingham Run 10k and Half Marathon will be returning to city with approximately 15,000 participants and will involve some road closures in your area. The event is being organised by The Great Run Company in conjunction with Birmingham City Council. The aim is to inspire more people to get active more regularly and many runners will be raising money for local and national charities.

You can find more information on the event route and, should you be interested, how to enter the event via **greatrun.org/Birmingham**. Local companies are also invited to take part in this year's Business Challenge event, which is open to groups of 4 or more. Businesses can sign up online at **greatrun.org/business-challenge**

To ensure the safety of participants it will be necessary to implement a rolling programme of road closures from 04:30. The reopening of roads will be done in phases between 12:00 – 16:00 following the last runners, the removal of infrastructure and road cleansing.

The course map and affected roads are detailed in this leaflet but please see **greatrun.org/Birmingham** for further details.

New for 2025: The AJ Bell Junior and Mini Great Birmingham Run will take place on Saturday 3rd May 2025 at Alexander Stadium, giving our younger runners the chance to take centre stage. Mini runners (aged 3-8) take on a 1.5km dash, while Junior runners (aged 9-15) tackle a supercharged 2.5km sprint.

PLEASE NOTE:

- During the road closures, vehicular access will not be possible unless otherwise stated or pre-agreed. If you require your vehicle during closure times, we recommend you park outside of the road closure area.
- Please note that side roads may be affected by the closures.
- Where possible, it would be appreciated if cars can be parked on driveways or on side streets. We will have an uplift system in place on event day to relocate vehicles left on the route. Parking suspensions will be in force from midnight on Saturday 3rd May. Vehicles removed may be subject to a penalty charge notice, so please remove vehicles before closures come into effect.
- Advance warning signage advising of the road closures and parking suspensions will be installed along the route two weeks prior to the event.
- Pedestrian and emergency access will be maintained to all properties throughout the event.

We understand that the road closures will cause some inconvenience. We will endeavour to minimise disruption to the road network and ensure roads are returned to normal traffic conditions in a timely fashion.
